The mission of Bitácora Millennium DiPr. is to promote the study and research of Private International Law. Our journal is specializing in Private International European Union Law, international and Compared Spanish Law (conflict of internal Law) and Interregional Law. The journal pays special attention to practical legal studies. The intended audience is researchers, academic members and legal professionals, interested in Private International Law.

Bitácora Millennium DiPr. is peer-edited (is edited by professionals in Private International Law), and refereed.

Currently, we have produced 8 issues. The first issue was launched in June 2015, and the last one (number 8, it is still in pre-edition ) in December 2018.

Usually, the number of articles in an issue is between 10 and 5. The average length of an article is between 10-15 pages.

Our journal is biannual, it is published twice a year, in June and in December.

### **Quality control system of the publication**

In order to guarantee the highest quality of the works that are going to be published, Bitácora Millennium DiPr. It has a double rigorous quality control:

- In the first instance, the scientific organ of the Bitácora (v. Functions of the Editorial Board) once received the works will proceed to accept or reject them, taking into account the subject and its adaptation to the objectives of the Millennium DiPr Journal.

- In a second moment, the accepted originals will be submitted to an evaluation process by "blind peers", at the same time and anonymously, and an additional report may be requested if deemed appropriate.

The external evaluators will be independent professionals and their names will be published annually in order to guarantee maximum transparency in the process of admission and evaluation of originals.

The system of control of the contributions can have like result its acceptance without suggestions, well its acceptance conditional to the revision or correction, or its denial.

The authors will be informed of the result of the evaluation process and will be able to send, if they wish, the observations or suggestions that they deem appropriate to the evaluators after knowing their reports.

### **Instructions for authors:**

The articles must be original. Interest, legal rigor, relevance and connection with practice will be valued. To guarantee the quality of the publication, a system of selection of originals submitted for review by external reviewers to the Journal is articulated, according to the system of "blind pairs", which ensures the anonymity of the author and the reviewer.

The receipt of the works will be acknowledged within 7 days. Based on the reports prepared by the external evaluators, the author will be informed, within one month, except in exceptional circumstances, whether or not his contribution is accepted for publication.

Millennium Blog DiPr. does not charge fees for publication or for article processing (APC).

Extension: about 9 pages in Word format (doc. Document) in which the footnotes are included. In justified cases, a larger extension will be accepted

Abstract of 2 lines maximum in Spanish, and in English, and keywords: maximum 4.

Letter: Arial.

Size: 12 pt

Line spacing: simple.

Justified text.

Articles: The title of the work is in quotation marks, and in italics only the magazine or collective work. Example: PAZ-ARES C. "Principle of efficiency and private law" in *AAVV Studies of Commercial Law in Homage to Professor M. Broseta Pont*, Volume III, Valencia 1995, p. 2843-2900
